

Lesson 13: Building Personal Capital

Rationale:

- ✓ A guest speaker who specializes in helping people to build personal capital would provide a more authentic experience for students.
- ✓ Students will have the opportunity to reflect on what their guest speaker has taught them through exploring goals of their own.

Activities:

Hook/ Review Activity: Explain to students that they will have a guest speaker today from the Royal Bank to explain to them about personal capital.

Mini-Lesson: The guest speaker will explain the concept of personal capital and how people gain more personal capital. Ensure to do student check-ins and make sure that the speaker is using student-friendly language.

Independent/ Collaborative Activity: After the guest speaker, debrief with students. What was most surprising about the presentation? Based on the information presented, have students create a plan to predict how they will build their own personal capital (Personal Capital Plan).

Sharing: Have some students share their predictions from their Personal Capital Plan.
